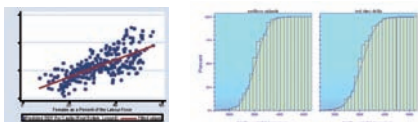
The Cathie Marsh Centre for Census and Survey Research offers a masters degree with a focus on statistical modelling.
